Terms of Warranty:

- All repairs under warranty shall be subject to proof of purchase.

Exclusions:

- Normal wear and tear.
- Abusive use.
- Exposure to fuels, fertilisers, oils, acids and other chemicals for a lengthy time period without prompt flushing off with water.
- UV attack.
- Colour matching of any repair.
- Exposure to heavy, sharp articles which will cause cut damage
